Team Size

The desired team size will be 4 female and 4 male athletes. The ABA reserves the right to vary the team size of the project based on interest level, athlete performance level and logistical considerations.

Selection Date

Notification of selection to the team will be made the week of Oct. 22, 2023.

Eligibility

To be eligible for selection to the team athletes must:

- Possess a current ABA license.
- Be born between 2007 and 2010 inclusive (ages 15-18 in 2025).

Selection Criteria

Athletes will be selected to the team objectively by both points, and subjectively by committee selection. Selection will be made in the following priority:

Selection by Points

Points will be earned at all Alberta Cyclocross races up until Oct. 22, 2024, including the Western Challenge. Points will be awarded in the Open Women and Open Men categories, when age specific categories are not offered, as indicated in Table 1 on the next page. Ties will be broken by the result at the Western Challenge. The team will be selected as:
